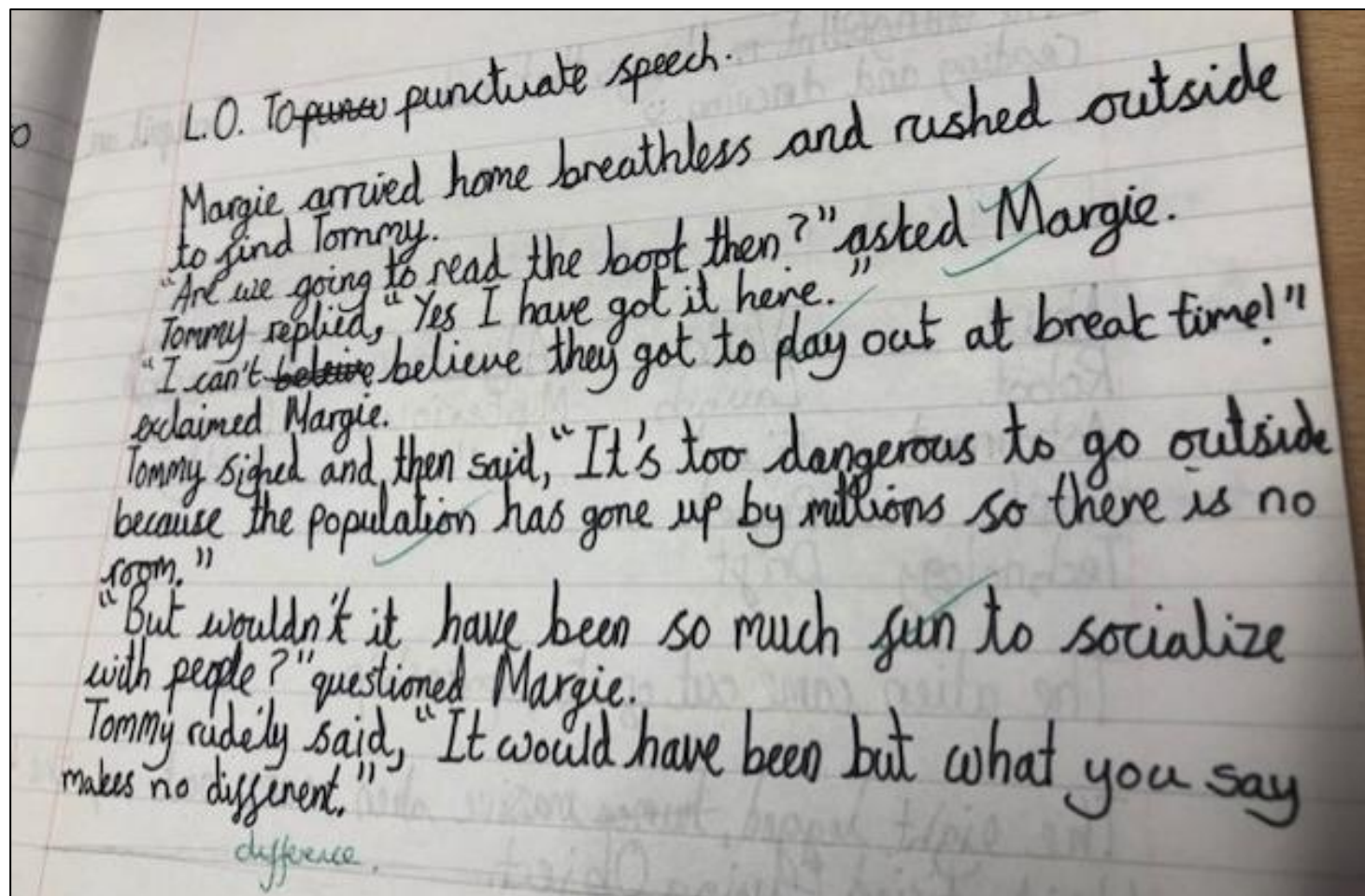
Margie arrived home breathless and rushed outside to find Tommy.
