History/English: Investigate the different types of architecture in Ancient Greece. How is this different from today?	English: Write a biography for a Greek God of your choice. Please include a picture of your chosen God.	Drama: Ancient Greeks loved the theatre. Write out your own play to perform to the class. You could take photos of yourself dressed up acting it out at home.	Art: Investigate photos/artwork of Greek artefacts to inspire your own picture - use paints, pastels, pencils or collage.
English/Art: Make a name plaque written in Greek letters.	Art/DT: Design your own Greek temple.	DT/English: Greek recipe instructions Cook a Greek meal for your family. Write the recipe for it and please include some photos to show us!	English/Art: Design a comic strip recalling a Greek Myth of your choice.
English: Write your own mythical story set in Ancient Greece.	Science: What was invented in Ancient Greek times? How did they cope without the technology we have today? Make a fact sheet with your ideas.	English: Imagine you are a journalist. Write a newspaper article recalling one of the Greek myths of your choice.	English/ICT: Research what it was like for children in Ancient Greece and write an information poster using ICT.
English: Find out what it was like for slaves in Ancient Greece. Imagine you are a slave and write a diary entry describing your day.	Maths: Make a timeline of at least 5 key events from the Ancient Greek period. Think carefully about ordering numbers and positioning them on a number line.	Geography: Draw and label a map of Greece and plan a trip there. Which modes of transport would you use and which countries would you pass over/through?	DT/Art: Design and make your own mythical creature.
Maths: Find out how many Olympics medals were won by different countries during the last Olympics. Present your data in different ways, for example, a bar chart, table or line graph. Can you explain what you found?	RE: How do different religions' theories today differ to the Greek God's that were worshipped during Ancient Greece?	Maths: Write 3 Ancient Greek word problems and show how you would solve them. For example, an Ancient Greek lady spends 2 hours at the theatre, 30 minutes at the market and 1 hour 20 minutes at the temple. How long was she out for?	Free Greek Choice: Choose your own project related to Ancient Greece. Surprise me with your creativity!
DT: Design your own Labyrinth. It could be made of straws, string or wood.	English: Research the Ancient Greek alphabet then choose five English words and write them in Ancient Greek.	Art: Find out about the clothes Ancient Greeks wore. Draw and label a picture showing a typical Ancient Greek outfit.	Invent your own Greek god. Draw them and then write a description of their powers, appearance and what they were in charge of e.g. the god of thunder.
