Early Maths

- Number hunt- can you find any numbers around your house or look around when you are on a walk? Look for door numbers, bus numbers or even the clock.
- Shape hunt- look around you house or while out on a walk can you see any shapes? Perhaps take some photos or draw the shapes you have seen.
- Counting games/ songs- we have practised '5 little ducks' and '1,2 buckle my shoe' at school. Do you know any more? Perhaps you could draw '5 little ducks'.
- Can you help lay the table? Count out the correct amount of cups, plates or forks.

Early Literacy

- Practise name writing and recognition. How many interesting ways can you write your name?
- What sound does your name begin with? Can you find somethings around your house that begin with the same sound? Perhaps write a list of all these things.
- Enjoy a bed time story! What is your favourite story? Can you draw a character from the story?

Wider Curriculum

- Use a tablet, computer or a book to find out a fun fact about ducklings. Perhaps you could share this with the class.
- Look at yourself in a mirror! Can you draw a picture of yourself? What colour are your eyes or hair?
