






FACT 1






SCORE HIGHER IN TESTS ACROSS ALL SUBJECTS.

FACT 2

... CHILDREN WHO READ FOR PLEASURE WHEN YOUNG ARE HAPPIER IN THEIR JOBS WHEN THE MY JOB BECOME ADULTS.

(and get paid more, on average).

Research shows that...

"Children who choose to read books for pleasure outside of school are more likely to secure managerial or professional jobs in later life."

(Demos, 2018).

It has more of an impact than:

- -Where a child comes from;
- -What their parent does for a job.

FACT 4



CHILDREN WHO READ OFTEN HAVE STRONGER RELATIONSHIPS THAN CHILDREN WHO DON'T READ!

Research shows that...

"Children who read show more empathy for others — they have a heightened ability to understand the feelings and beliefs of others."

(Kidd, 2013).

They also report:

- -Having more close relationships;
- -Have more people that they consider as friends.

FACT 5

THERE IS EVEN EVIDENCE THAT PEOPLE WHO READ AS CHILDREN LIVE LONGER,, HEALTHIER, LIVES! (on average)



Research shows that...


"People who read books for 30 minutes a day live, on average nearly two-years longer than non-readers."

It is thought to be because:


- -Knowledge about health;

Both bars were then allowed to set overnight in the fridge.


