Child A came to Debden School in January 2016 - 1/3 of the way through year 6.

Although she did make ARE in R, W or M she achieved these are her scaled scores: R - 92, GPS - 93 and made ARE in M - 101. She was given specific interventions after PPM with myself and her teachers. She had specific difficulties in moving beyond the literal in reading and her spelling let her down in both the GPS and explained why she didn't make ARE in writing.
