We were also fortunate to be visited by Mr Richard Cawtes, who came in and read the proclamation in assembly to the children.

Year 6 SATS

SATs will be taking place for Year 6 children next week. The children have been working hard and have made great progress - we are confident that they will do themselves proud! Below is the schedule:

Date and Time	Assessment
Monday 12 th May 2025 – 9am	English spelling, punctuation and grammar (papers 1 and 2)
Tuesday 13 th May 2025 – 9am	English Reading
Wednesday 14 th May 2025 – 9am	Maths Papers 1 and 2 (break in between)
Thursday 15 th May 2025 – 9am	Maths Paper 3

The KS1 assessments will follow later in the year. The KS1 assessments are now non-statutory and so the timetable for the assessments is less rigid, and we will inform you of when these assessments are taking place for your child in due course. We opt for the children to still informally sit the KS1 assessments, as they provide a solid marker for how children are progressing against national expectations.

Assessments can affect all children differently, and we try where we can to alleviate the pressure that some children may feel.
