#### Dear Parents,

We hope that you all enjoyed a pleasant half term and are delighted to welcome the children back for term 2.



The start of this term is an exceptionally important time for us all here at Debden Primary Academy, as we prepare to commemorate Remembrance Day. As a school that is immensely proud of its strong links to Carver Barracks, and in respect to the high proportion of armed forces families amongst our community, we place a great deal of value on ensuring that our children recognise the importance of this occasion. We shall be paying homage to the theme of Remembrance through themes and activities during next

week. Furthermore, as is customary, our Year 5 and 6 children shall be participating in the Debden Village Act of Remembrance this coming Monday, to honour to the memory of local people from the armed forces who have died in the line of duty. Whilst this is a village event, parents are welcome to join – it commences at approximately 10.50 am outside the YUVA restaurant opposite the school.

We have been really pleased with the effort and enthusiasm that the children have been showing on their return to school this week. I have had the privilege of listening to some of the Minnows children articulately reading their imaginative 'Superhero' poems and have also observed the Frogs children diligently learning their times tables – highly impressive! I know that Mrs Stoyle and Mr Brown have been equally impressed with some of the fantastic learning that has been taking place in the Ducklings and Kingfishers classrooms. If the children sustain such fantastic determination and creativity throughout the year, I have no doubt that they will make amazing progress!

Onto some rather more difficult news - it is with regret that I must inform you that Mrs Hood shall not be returning to her post at Debden from her current absence. Mrs Hood is a longstanding and well-liked member of the team, and so this news is saddening for all of us. However, we can completely understand her decision, and would like to wish her well in everything that she does in the future. We are hoping that she will be able to come into school at some point before Christmas so that we can give her a proper send-off!

Our EYFS curriculum will be led by the highly capable Mrs Stoyle in the short-term, whilst Mrs Cole (who has built an excellent relationship with the children over the past few weeks) will continue to teach the Ducklings class in the latter part of the week. The Ducklings children will also continue to be supported by Mrs Cameron and Mrs Pargeter. We shall be looking to recruit a permanent member of staff for the vacant teaching role in the very near future and will of course keep you updated.

As previously communicated, our latest Ofsted report is now available for parents to browse, and you should have already received a copy of this via email. We have had relatively few queries regarding the report thus far. However, I am sure that there must be some comments and questions that parents would like to raise, and I would really like to ensure that everyone's minds are put at rest! Therefore, I will be holding an Ofsted Presentation/ Question & Answer Session at 2.15pm (directly before achievement assembly) next Friday, the 15<sup>th</sup> November. For anyone who is unable to make this time, I am more than happy to make individual appointments to answer questions that you may have.
