Investigate where the major pyramids are located and mark them on a map of Egypt. (Don't forget to add the Nile as a guide.) Which things are Human or Physical features?	Using your own Egyptian research, type up a digital fact file about an Egyptian God or Goddess. Can you add a picture too.	Write a seasonal acrostic poem. OR... Write an acrostic poem a word from ancient Egypt.	Find the British museum website and check out their excellent facts and artefacts. Go on their virtual tour then write a recount of what you saw and remembered.
Research, design and create your own Shaduf using appropriate materials. Explain its use.	Design a poster for a fossil exhibition at a local venue.	Who was Cleopatra and what can you find out about her?	Write some secret messages using Hieroglyphics.
Choose a book that you read recently and write a diary entry from one of the characters.	Design and make a sarcophagus with Embellishments. Think about the net of the shape.	On a world map, label the 7 Continents, 5 Oceans and the Equator. If this is too easy add some of the seas and countries.	Write an alternate ending to a book that you have read. How does your version improve on the original?
