


Topic Based Learning



Physical Development (Gross and Fine Motor)

- Use your pincer grip to peg some pants on the washing line. Can you make a pattern?
- Use playdough or clay to mould an alien. Think carefully about how many arms, legs or heads it might have?

Understanding the World/ Expressive Art and Design

- Look at the underpants in our book of the week. What patterns can you see? Spots, stripes or swirls? Can you design a pattern for underpants? Cut them out and peg on the line. Watch out in case any sneaky aliens steal them!
- Explore how different materials mix by testing some underpants. What happens when you brush on watery paint? (Resource on School Website)
- Using different collage materials, can you make an alien? Think about how to join the materials and what colours you might use?
- Can you grow an alien using a balloon? Use the resource on the school website for this science experiment. What happening to the balloon? How is it changing? (Resource on School Website)

- Make a paper plate spaceship for the aliens in the story. Can you use the stick puppets to retell the story of 'Aliens Love Underpants'. (Resource on School Website)
