Day 2 LO To use mapping skills


Now you have identified the countries of North America it is time to find them on a map. Find and label each country on the map of the Americas on the next page.

Pick a state and then find out some geographical information;


Where is the state?

Once you have carried out your research you will need to write a best copy using the next page, or in your own style. - This work should take 2 sessions.







Day 8 The Physical Geography of North America


Lo To use mapping skills
