## Key Words/ Sight Words w.c 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2021

Each week a set (s) of key words will be sent home. The children we need to learn to read these by sight.

- \* The words in colour are tricky words (these are words that are not phonetic- the children cannot sound them out). The children will need to learn these by sight-by looking at the word and recognising.
- \* The other key words are high frequency words. These are words that appear lots in books, captions etc. These words are phonetic but the children will again need to learn them by sight- without sounding out.

Practise these words daily with the children (along with phonics sound cards). Little and often works well as spotting these words in books. Play games such as pairs, hide and go seek, tricky word splat etc.
