

How does the distance between the light source and the object affect the size of the shadow

My prediction

the distance between the light and object.	the shadow	Object light source Distance between object and paper


Our results

Distance between torch and object (cm)	Width of shadow (cm)
20 cm	5 cm
40 cm	4 cm
60 cm	3 and 1/2 cm

Conclusion

The results show that the distance of the distance of the light source does affect the size of the shadow.

The further the distance the smaller the shadow.



1. The White Rabbit's Watch
 The White Rabbit checks his watch every 4 minutes. ✓
 How many times does he check it in 2 hours? *30 times*

2. Down the Rabbit Hole ✓
 Alice falls for 18 seconds.
 Each second she falls 7 metres.
 How far does she fall?
*1 hour = 15 miles
 60 ÷ 4 = 15
 15 × 2 = 30*

4. Drink Me Potion (Decimals) ✓
 Alice is 1.35 m tall.
 She grows to 3 times her height.
 What is her new height?
4.05 m or 4.05 m

5. The Mad Hatter's Tea Party (Time) ✓
 The tea party starts at 2:45 pm.
 It lasts 1 hour and 35 minutes.
 What time does it end?
2.45 + 1:35 = 4:20

7. Playing Cards (Ratio)
 The ratio of red cards to black cards is 3:2.
 There are 30 red cards.
 How many black cards are there?
*5 × 40 = 20
 50 ÷ 10 = 5
 2 × 10 = 20
 20 - 10 = 10*
